- God wants you to prosper and be complete
- Notice the progression from one covenant to the next.
- Adam and Eve were given seed-bearing plants to eat.
- God gave Noah plants and meat, and the terror of him would be everywhere.
- God wanted Abraham to be blessed so that he could be a blessing. He also would curse anyone who cursed Abe.
- It's hard to be a blessing if you are miserable, poor, and diseased.
